



SLU 101 Basic Information

What to Bring:

Bible	Sunscreen	Personal hygiene items
Clothes	Camera	Good attitude

Money – you may want to bring extra spending money for snacks, souvenirs, etc.
Sweatshirt

Phone Home:

To call home directly from the hotel, you must have a cell phone, calling card or use the pay phones throughout the lobby. Phones in your room will not be available for outgoing calls.

Attire:

Wear casual clothes that are suitable for the hot summer climate, as well as suitable clothing for a young leader. In case you are the type of person who likes specifics, here are a few guidelines:

- T-shirts are OK as long as there are no questionable slogans
- No tank tops, halter tops, spaghetti straps, or midriff-bearing shirts
- Shorts should be a modest length (no shorter than approximately 5" above the knee)
- Comfortable shoes
- In case you have any free time at the pool, bring a one-piece swimsuit.
- Please note that meeting rooms are typically cold which is why we suggest you bring a sweatshirt.

Remember, please dress very modestly. If any of our SLU staff has a problem with what you are wearing, you will be asked to change. Basic rule: "err on the side of caution."

Medical Release Form:

Group leaders must bring a medical release form for any minors attending without a parent/guardian. Any student attending without a chaperone must bring a completed SLU Medical Release Form (available on your online account) to turn in at registration.

Travel:

For singles (those not attending in a group), students will be met at the baggage claim areas for the respective airlines on which they are flying. Due to Transportation Safety Administration regulations we are unable to meet students at the gate. We are not able to accept unaccompanied minors flying on any airline. Students will be put on a commercial shuttle service or a taxi with other program participants and will be transported to the program hotel. At the end of the program, approximately 2:30 pm, students will be put on a commercial shuttle service or a taxi with other program participants and transported back to the airport.

Rooming:

All rooms are QUAD occupancy. If you are a single, SLU will place you in a room with other singles. All rooms have two double beds and there are no rollaway beds available. There will be an additional charge for rooms with less than four people in the room. Rooms may not be co-ed unless members of the same family. Students under 18 may not room alone. Rooms will be available at 3:00 pm.

Frequently Asked Questions

What will I be doing at SLU?

There is a sample itinerary on our website. You will be participating in leadership training which will help you realize who you are, what God has called you to do, and how to begin working toward those goals NOW. 26 hours of intense training is mixed with behind-the-scenes experiences at Sea World and other theme parks.

How can I be preparing now for my SLU experience?

First of all, you can decide that you are going to get the most you can out of the experience by fully engaging in the sessions and training. We also encourage you to pray about what the Lord is going to teach you while you are at SLU and how He wants to use you to impact the world. READ as much as you can...the Bible, leadership material, newspapers, etc. For a suggested reading list, visit our website.

What qualifies a “group?”

A group is any number of students with at least one adult. (For example: one student and one adult, or 20 students and one adult).

What does a “single” mean?

A single is any student who comes without an adult. These students may come alone or with friends, but they do not have a group leader over 18 years old who has graduated from high school.

If I am coming by myself, who will I be staying with?

If you register as a single, SLU will place you in a room with other singles. Our pricing is based on four people per room, so you will have 3 roommates unless there are not enough singles to fill that room. All rooms have two double beds and there are no rollaway beds available.

Are there rollaway beds available?

Rollaway beds are available in king rooms, but will not be available in double bed rooms.

How old do I have to be to come to SLU?

As a single, you must be at least 15 years old. If you are coming with a group, you must be at least in 8th grade and have approval from your group leader.

Will I need transportation while I am at SLU?

Once you arrive at the hotel, you will not need transportation. SLU provides transportation to all of our off-site experiences.

I am bringing my car to SLU. Do I need to pay for parking?

Payment for parking varies according to hotel property. You can confirm this with the hotel once you register for SLU. You should plan on parking your car and not using it until the last SLU session is completed.

What does my SLU Staff Member do?

The SLU Summer Staff is made up of college students who are leaders on their campuses. Some are hand chosen to represent their university at SLU, and others are SLU Alumni who have completed at the least the first three levels of our SLU programs. They give their summer to serve you in every capacity. They will help guide you through the week, take care of any questions or details that you need assistance with, and just hang out with you.
